Upload and email to Sarah Majoros one PDF document* with all of the following information:

- Application Cover Page
- Adapted District Data Profile**
- Section cover page, narrative, and content documentation for all seven sections
 - Beliefs, Vision, and Mission
 - Professional Competencies
 - School Counseling Program Goals
 - School Counseling Core Curriculum
 - Small Group Responsive Services
 - Closing the Gap
 - Program Evaluation Reflection

Please be sure that each section is easily identifiable by including a section cover page identifying each individual section of the application.

Narratives may be written in the voice (I or we) that is most appropriate to the section. Each level may provide a narrative if it best conveys the information sought in each section as long as there is a representation of all levels K-12.

Application Deadline: December 15, 2019.

*The PDF document must be organized for ease in reviewing. Please ensure that all documents are right side up and oriented to portrait. Each section should be organized as 1) section cover page, 2) narrative, and 3) all listed supporting documentation.
