Upload and email to Shelly Adams one PDF document* with all of the following information:

- Application Cover Page
- Adapted School Data Summary**
- Section cover page, reflection, and content documentation for all six sections
 - o Vision and Mission
 - o Annual Student Outcome Goals
 - o Classroom & Group Mindsets and Behaviors Action Plan
 - o Annual Administrative Conference
 - o Annual Calendar
 - o Classroom Instruction Results Report OR Small-Group Results Report

Please be sure that each section is easily identifiable by including a section cover page identifying each individual section of the application.

Reflections may be written in the voice (I or we) that is most appropriate to the section. Each level may provide a reflection if it best conveys the information sought in each section as long as there is a representation of all levels K-12.

Application Deadline: December 15, 2024.

*The PDF document must be organized for ease in reviewing. Please ensure that all documents are right side up and oriented to portrait. Each section should be organized as 1) section cover page, 2) reflection, and 3) all listed supporting documentation.
